- A. Call to Order by Steve Gerlitz @ 7 p.m.
- B. Agenda approved under MOTION by Gail Millard, carried.
- C. Minutes of the December meeting will be read and approved at the February meeting.
- D. Business Arising from the Minutes
 - a. The building's locks have been re-keyed. The exterior doors are all the same. The bar is separate. Jamie will have a sign in/sign out sheet available for anyone needing keys.
 - b. The Curling Club Sustainability project totaling \$77,042.50 consists of flooring at \$41,842.50, washroom upgrades at \$15,000, arena lights at \$20,000 and signage costing \$200.
 - 1. Payment of the project will come from a Canada 150 Grant in the amount of \$38,432, a CFEP grant for \$20,000 and the balance of \$18,621.50 will come from SCC proceeds.
 - 2. The upgrade project must be completed by March 31, 2017. No funding for next year
 - 3. Proof of payment needs to be submitted to the Canadian Government.
 - 4. Steve has looked after the completed grants and has signed the funding agreement
 - 5. Friday, Jan 20/17 @ 10 a.m. a public announcement at the Curling Club will be made regarding the grants.
 - 6. The club has an open term loan at ATB secured by the SCC building title which is valued at \$560,000 in order to pay outstanding bills until our grants come through.
 - 7. Our share of the funding will come from the 2016/2017 raffle profits and casino funds.
 - 8. Jamie and Joe assisted to make sure the flooring/painting/washrooms were completed during the Christmas/New Year break.
 - 9. The arena LED lights must be in by March 31, 2017 therefore the last week of curling will be after the Ladies Bonspiel is over on March 12.
 - c. Cervus Equipment Farmer / Farmerettes Bonspiel January 19 22/17
 - i) Advertising Jamie had the neon sign changed and Gail asked the radio station to announce the bonspiel in December
 - ii) Sponsorship
 - 1. Cervus Equipment will have 2 title sponsor banners
 - 2. ID Apparel did the event prizes. We have a \$850. bill to pay there.

- 6. Ralph will be contacted by Steve to hold 50/50 raffles Friday and Saturday night.
- 7. Collin was unsuccessful in getting pie and drink sponsorship.

A suggestion was made that a sign be made for the downstairs kitchen that food is available in the upstairs kitchen. Roxanne jumped on that one!

The Kinsmen have approx. 16 teams registered for their bonspiel on Jan. 27-28 wknd.

He will look into an inexpensive portable one. Collin is Interested in growing our club by including two-person doubles teams which is becoming popular in other clubs and possibly skins curling.
